



General Professional Skills (ABV) Study Field





Our annual programme (ABV)

- 70 Colloquia: ≈ 1400 participants
- 6 project modules:≈ 200 participants
- 14 basic trainings for mentors:≈ 280 participants
- 12 additional trainings for mentors:≈ 180 participants
- About 30 lectures
- ≈ 1.200 internship reports
 (actual internship data base contains about 10.000 reports)


Great demand, but no Career Service Staff for counselling!




